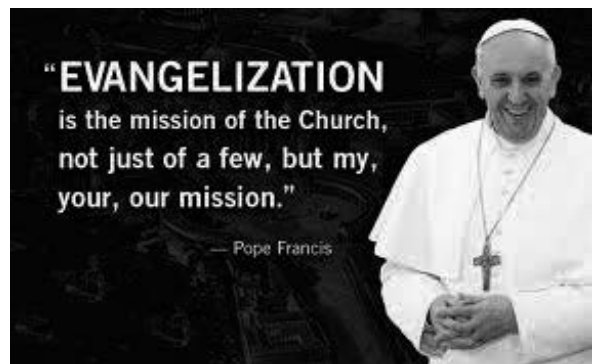

## Madison Diocesan CCW Convention, 2024

On Tuesday, June 18, 2024 women from around the diocese gathered at St. James Church in Madison for the 69<sup>th</sup> annual Madison Diocesan Council of Catholic Women Convention. St. Joseph the Worker Pastorate was represented at the convention by Kitty Mumm, Sandy Kalnins, Leigh Boorn and Bernadette Schaefer.

Bishop Hying reflected on the theme of the convention, "The Eucharist - God's Gift of Unending Love." In his talk he gave three suggestions that will make the Mass more meaningful: read the scripture passages before Mass, bring the prayers, sacrifices and good works of the past week and offer them at Mass, attend Eucharistic Adoration. He quoted St. Teresa of Avila who said, "The Lord of the Eucharist wants to reign on the throne of your heart."

Following Bishop Hying's talk we attended Mass and installed the officers. Carol Rogers, Fennimore, is president. Carolyn Zentner, Princeton, and Jane Lepeska Grinde, Madison, are co-president-elect. Marie Fleisner, Watertown, is secretary, and Patty Spragg, Baraboo, is treasurer.

After lunch Anne Auger, Director of Evangelization for the St. Therese of Lisieux Pastorate, spoke about the abiding presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. She said that "Yahweh" means the God of presence; He longs to be with us, to remain with us in the simple, humble form of bread. We respond in gratitude by bringing His presence to the people around us.

The 2024 Diocesan CCW Convention provided a wonderful opportunity to deepen our understanding and belief in the real presence of Jesus in the Eucharist, and to strengthen our commitment to sharing His presence with others.
