Live in the Light is a series of Gospel reflections written by Laura Sokup, the Mental Wellness Program Coordinator for the Diocese of Madison. These Gospel reflections, highlighting Jesus's compassion for humanity, will lead up to the St. Dymphna Healing Mass held at Holy Name Heights on October 6th at 10 AM. This special Mass celebrated by Bishop Hying will be for those experiencing mental health challenges as well as their families, friends, and caregivers. All who attend will have the opportunity to receive the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick and a chance to venerate a first-class relic of St. Dymphna, the patron saint of mental illness. Mass will be followed by a light reception and more information on Catholic mental health resources.
